Best 7 Things to Check for Reviewing Accessibility of a Course

Accessible syllabus

- Including a statement from Disability Services
- > Document prepared with the following in mind:
 - Use **heading styles** to organize the syllabus
 - Use meaningful descriptions for embedded links, not cutting and pasting the full text of a link
 - Included alternative text for any IMAGES, graphics, tables
 - Use Lists (MS Word's built-in tools) to organize the content structure
- Using Accessibility Checker for Microsoft Word to review the syllabus document for accessibility
- > Making sure the .pdf version of syllabus document is accessible

Handouts

- > Having printed and electronic version of handouts
- > All electronic versions of the handouts are accessible (Word and .pdf)

PowerPoint and/or other presentations

- PowerPoint and/or other presentations are available electronically in an accessible format
- Using Accessibility Checker for Microsoft Word to review the PPT slide handouts for accessibility
- > Accessible alternatives to any non-accessible presentations such as Prezi are provided

Videos

- All recorded video materials (Zoom, YouTube, video podcasts, DVDs, etc) with closed captioning/subtitles
- Editing and correcting will be necessary after Zoom or YouTube automatically transcribes

Audio

Regarding audio materials (audio clips, audio podcasts, CDs, etc), if the content is not the same as the recorded video materials, it is required to provide a transcript

Other online materials/resources

Online resources (websites, blogs, references, support materials) meet the W3C accessibility standards

LMS Accessibility (Blackboard)

- Any documents uploaded to the LMS have been reviewed for accessibility. The information is provided/delivered in various ways (i.e.,. Word, PPT, Video, and .pdf). Scanned documents can be accessible with Adobe Pro software
- > Links are created with meaningful descriptions
- > Text has not been copied and pasted from Word
- > Alternative text for images, graphics, tables
- > Not using colored fonts to convey meaning
- > Color contrast, light fonts or poor contrast, is avoided
- Background patterns are simple
